## BY-LAW 06-10

A BY-LAW TO IMPOSE AND COLLECT FEES & CHARGES AS CONSIDERED NECESSARY BY COUNCIL.

WHEREAS Section 247 of the Municipal Act, being Chapter 154 of the Revised Statutes of the Yukon 2002 states that; Council may by by-law impose and collect fees, charges, fines and penalties as considered necessary by council.

WHEREAS section 344 of Municipal Act provides that a Council may by bylaw provide that in default of payment, an outstanding amount owing may be charged against the real property in respect of which a service was provided or expenditure was made, and that it may be recovered in the same manner as a tax may be collected or enforced under the Act.

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of the Municipality of the Town of Watson Lake in Open Meeting duly assembled, hereby ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. The Council of the Town of Watson Lake has established fees, charges, fines and penalties for the purpose of providing Municipal services, products and utilities which the Council considers is necessary or desirable for the residents of the municipality and under the control of Council have established the following conditions are to be applied. applied.
- 2. An interest charge of 2% per month will be applied to any amount remaining unpaid 30 days after the date of invoicing. Payments received will first be applied to interest and second to the principal balance.
- 3. If an account remains unpaid 90 days after the date of invoicing, no further services may be charged to the account or in the account holder's name until payment is received in full.
- 4. Any account that remains unpaid 120 days after the date of invoicing and providing satisfactory payment arrangements have not been made with the Town, the outstanding balance, including fines or penalties will be recovered in the same manner as a tax may be collected. Whereby there is no real property that the outstanding balance including fines or penalties may be recovered or collected from, will be subject to Small Claims Court action.
- 5. Any person or business that have not established residency within the Town Boundaries is considered a non-resident, and whereby any non-resident who makes application for any service under Section (1) will be required to pay in advance unless acceptable arrangements have been made with the Town of Watson Lake.
- 6. Any person or business that is not a registered property owner within the Town boundaries shall be required to pay in advance unless acceptable agreements have been made with the Town of Watson Lake.
- 7. This By-law shall come into full force and effect upon the final passing thereof.
