DELEGATIONS AT COUNCIL MEETINGS

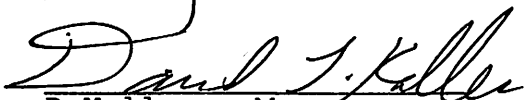
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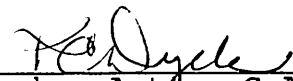
Council of the Town of Watson Lake recognizes that from time to time persons may wish to be present as a delegation before Council and establishes that:

- Delegations are welcome before Council at any regularly scheduled Council meeting.
- Delegations must advise the Clerk in writing prior to the scheduled Council meeting about the nature of the delegation and the issue the delegation is speaking to.
- The normal time frame allocated to any delegation will be limited to fifteen (15) minutes. Should Council determine that there is insufficient time to deal with the delegation, Council will establish a separate meeting to deal appropriately with the issue raised by the delegation.
